#### **APPEAL 2024!**


**HOPE when you are hungry.** Taylor and his son were homeless, and after living in a hotel for several months, they were

There are many elements to the season of Lent - prayer, fasting, or living a more virtuous life. The gospels throughout this season of Lent tends to deflate egos and to deflate our inflated sense of self while challenging us to any self deceit about the quality of our lives as followers of Christ. The gospels hit us again and again with demands which we not only fail to live up to, but which we come to recognize are quite beyond us. The gospel passages are meant to trouble us, to confront our illusions about ourselves, "Remember, you are dust...." From this perspective Lenten penance may be more effective if we fail in our resolutions than if we succeed. For its purpose is not to confirm us in our sense of virtue, but to bring us home to a radical need for God's salvation.




