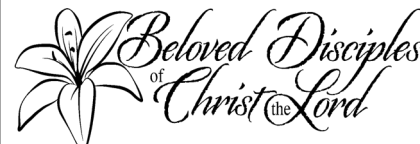

Message from the Moderator

Last week, the Diocese of Buffalo announced a new phase in responding to the needs of the Diocese. While this was not a complete surprise, it still comes far earlier than we were anticipating and demands that we accelerate our efforts at collaboration among the six Parishes in our Family far sooner than first thought. Please pray for our Family as its recently established leadership, both clergy and lay, will be involved in a process of making recommendations to the Diocese over the next couple months. Let me assure you that there is no predetermined conclusion. We must look at all aspects of the viability of all six Parishes in our Family and see how we can meet the Diocese's request for further merger and consolidation. We will keep you as informed as humanly possible through announcements at weekend Masses, the individual Parish bulletins, and the Family and Parish websites as this process begins in earnest this week. There will be many rumors out there that people will hear and pass along, but please do not jump to conclusions and wait until you hear officially from the leadership of our Family. May God bless us all in this new time of transformation. Pray that the Holy Spirit will guide us all so that we can continue to build a vibrant, faith-filled church community to face the challenges of the future.
