Diocesan Recommendations Update

This past Wednesday, August 14, the Renewal Team for the Diocese of Buffalo, along with Bishop Fisher himself met with representatives of the six Parishes in our Family to discuss five counterproposals presented to amend the Diocesan recommendations for merging and closing Parishes in our Family. The clergy of our Family, priests and deacons, along with two representatives from each Parish were present. The five proposals had been submitted previously after being prepared by each individual Parish utilizing the close to 100 written recommendations that were given by the Parishioners in our Family.

The meeting with the Diocese was a very positive experience and an honest dialogue was presented defending the present status of each of the six Parishes in our Family. The Diocese heard each recommendation and understands how important each Parish community is to their Parishioners. The Diocese thanked us for our input and promised to begin to prepare the final recommendations to be completed by August 26th for further consultation with the Council of Priests, with announcements around September 1st. We will announce these final mergers and closures as soon as they become available.

This is a challenging time for all of us. Please continue to pray for the Spirit to inspire us, to give us strength, and to recognize the difficult choices that must be made to build a stronger future for our Church in Western New York.
