

The program encourages families to make a personal commitment to pray for vocations daily by hosting the chalice in their home to increase the awareness of the need for more priestly vocations in our Diocese.

### How it works:

- Sign up for a week (Sunday to Saturday)



# Col 3:1-4


Paul urges the Corinthians to celebrate Jesus' death and resurrection with sincerity and truth. How does your family celebrate Easter Sunday?
