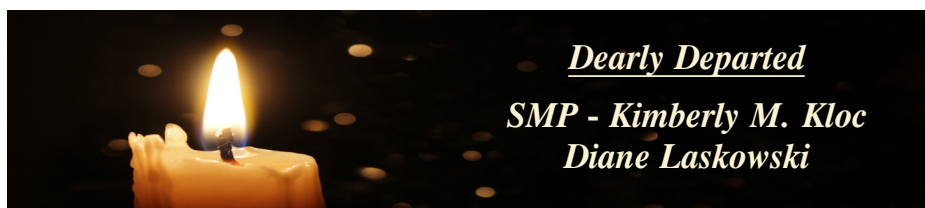

This 5-week course is for adults aged 18+ who have received the Sacraments of Baptism & Holy Communion. Confirmation, a Sacrament of Initiation, strengthens the baptized in faith & in their commitment to living it out. It also strengthens them to be witnesses of Christ by word and deed, and to spread and defend the faith. This course will cover the essentials of the Catholic faith, including sacred scripture, the Creed, and prayer. The Confirmation Liturgy will take place sometime in October or November.

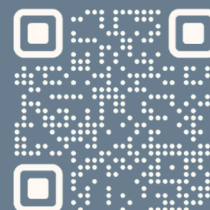

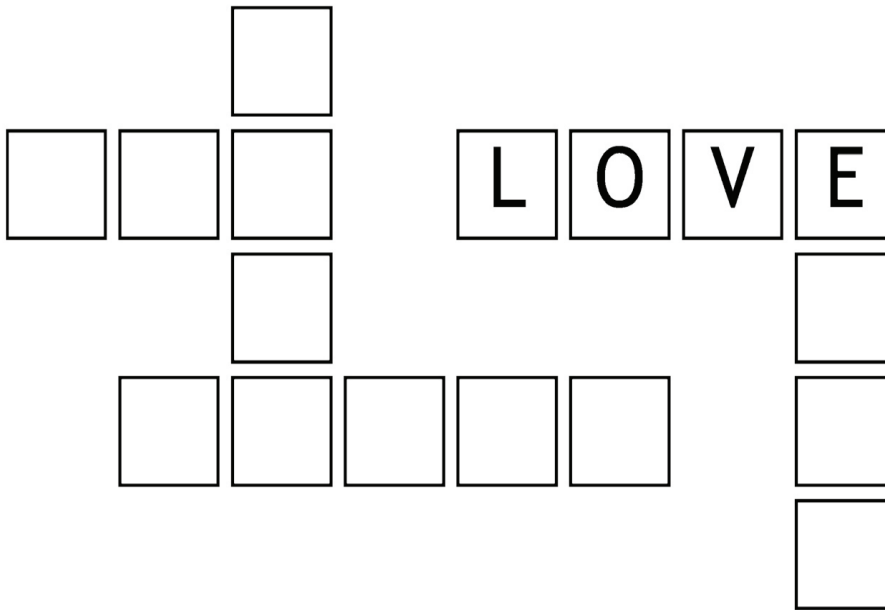
