



What could you give back to God this week out of gratitude?


### **1 Cor 11:23-26**

# DIOCESAN SETTLEMENT DISCUSSION

## Settlement Overview

On April 22, 2025, the Diocese of Buffalo announced a \$150 million settlement (in principle) with the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors in response to sexual abuse claims against the Diocese. The settlement contributions will come from: \$30M from the Diocese (cash & real estate), \$80M from parishes (unrestricted cash), \$30M from parish & Diocesan real estate, and \$10M from affiliated entities.

## Parish Contributions: The Formula

Contributions are based on a percentage (10%–80%) of each parish's unrestricted assets as of August 31, 2024. Higher percentages apply to parishes scheduled to close or merge under Road to Renewal.

No current Sunday collections or future donations will be used for the settlement.

*Unrestricted assets = funds not designated by a donor for a specific purpose.*

## Payment Details

This is a one-time payment, due July 15, 2025. No fundraising is required – payments come from existing unrestricted funds. There will be no additional pledges or fundraising needed.

***The money you put in today will be used to keep the lights on in our parishes, fund our ministries, and pay our staff.***

## Appealing Parishes

If a Parish is appealing their closure decree, they are still assessed at 80%. If appeal succeeds, parish receives a refund of the difference.

## Why All Parishes Participate

Nearly 50% of parishes in the Diocese have claims against them, including multiple parishes from our Family. Participation in the settlement through payment provides legal protection via Channeling Injunctions, covering existing claims and future claims if NY reopens its legal window for abuse cases.

## Faith and Justice

Together, we have a sacred responsibility to offer more than words—we are called to take real action to help bring healing and justice to those the Church has failed. This settlement, while it can never fully compensate survivors for their pain, is a meaningful step toward restitution for the physical, emotional, and spiritual scars they still endure. By contributing, we stand united as one Church, committing to do what is right, learning from the past, and preparing to serve our communities with integrity and compassion for years to come.

## How to Ensure Your Gifts Remain Restricted

Legally, restricted gifts can only be used for their stated purpose. Speak to your attorney, estate planner, or the Diocesan Development Department to learn how to designate your gifts.

## Commitment to Safety

The Diocese continues to enforce a Safe Environment Program, including: abuse prevention training, background checks, and strict conduct policies
