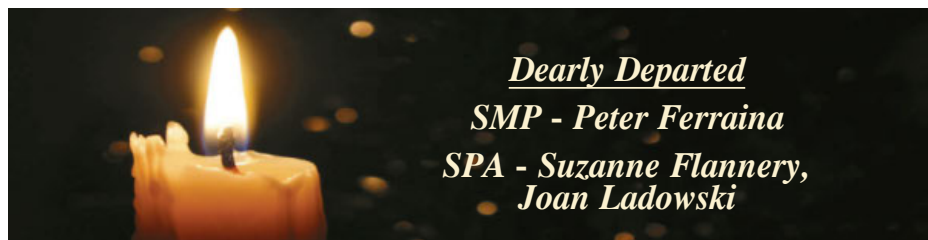

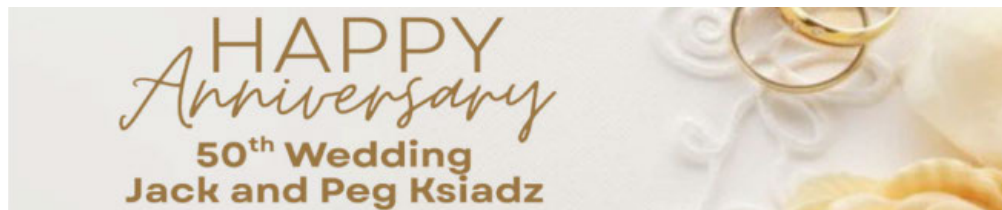

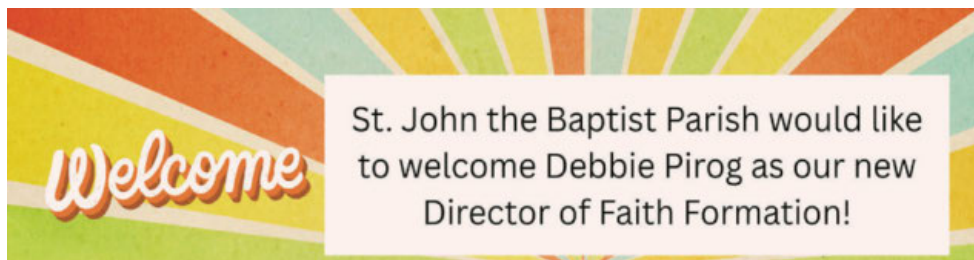

St. Peregrine Laziosi was born in 1260 in Forlì, Italy, into a wealthy family. He converted to Catholicism, later receiving a vision of the Virgin Mary instructing him to join the Servite Order. Ordained a priest, Peregrine returned to Forlì to found a Servite monastery. He became renowned for his lifestyle, never sitting down for years as a penance, and for his compassion toward the poor and sick. In his sixties, Peregrine developed cancer in his leg. Doctors advised amputation, but the night before surgery, he prayed before a crucifix and saw a vision of Christ healing him. The next day, his leg was completely cured. This miracle greatly increased his reputation for holiness.



Peregrine died in 1345 at age 85. He was canonized in 1726 by Pope Benedict XIII, and his feast day is celebrated on May 1. He is now venerated as the patron saint of those suffering from cancer and other life-threatening conditions.
