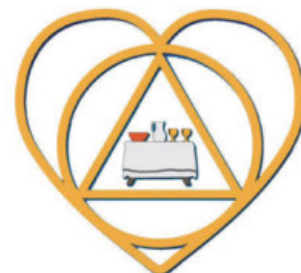

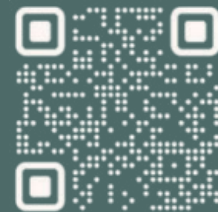

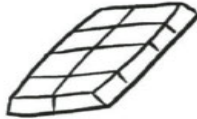
Give us today the courage to assist those around us who may need our assistance. Give us patience when we become impatient.

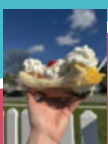
