





Newly Canonized Saints

Canonized September 7, 2025, by Pope Leo XIV in St. Peter's Square We joyfully celebrate the canonization of two inspiring young saints:

St. Carlo Acutis (1991–2006): A 15-year-old Italian known as "God's Influencer" for using his tech skills to share his love of the Eucharist and document Eucharistic miracles. He is the first millennial to be canonized. Feast Day: October 12

St. Pier Giorgio Frassati (1901–1925): A young Italian layman remembered for his joyful spirit, service to the poor, and active faith through Catholic Action. Feast Day: July 4

Pope Leo XIV reminded us in his homily that these saints call young people to "not squander their lives, but to direct them upwards and make them masterpieces."

May their lives inspire all of us-especially our youth-to grow in faith, holiness, and love for others.


