

Mass Intention & Sanctuary Lamp

Both are meaningful ways to offer prayers for loved ones or special intentions.

Mass Intentions are mentioned during the liturgy and remembered by the priest throughout the Mass. Mass Intention offerings go to the priest who celebrates the Mass.

Sanctuary Lamps burn near the tabernacle to honor Christ's presence. Though always lit, intentions are offered for a full week. (Note: Not all parishes offer this.) Donations for this request cover candle and other Mass costs.

These intentions can be requested by anyone—for birthdays, anniversaries, prayers of thanksgiving, and especially in remembrance of deceased loved ones.




