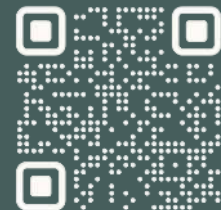

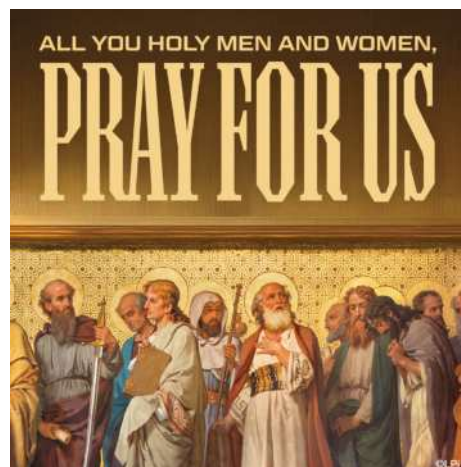
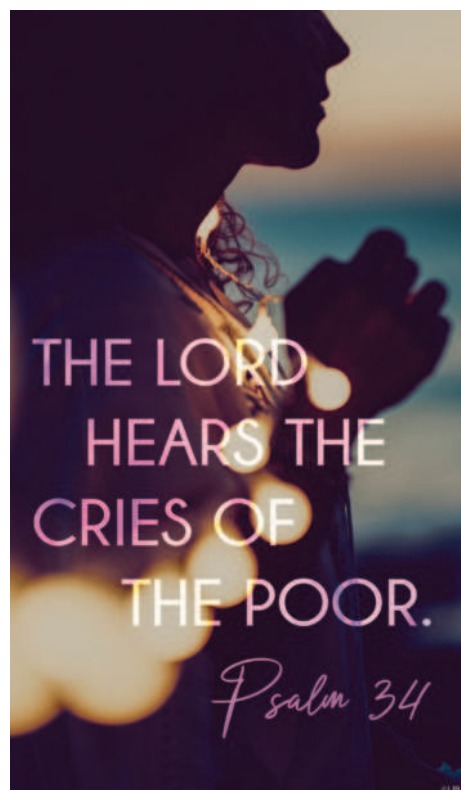
Sirach teaches us that God cares deeply about our desire for justice. Can you think of a time when you fought against an unjust situation?

For your regular collection:

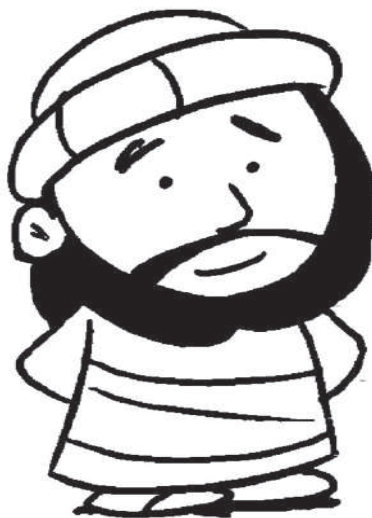
You're welcome to give weekly, monthly, or annually—whatever works best for you. You may combine multiple into one check. We do not enter these by the date on the envelope.
