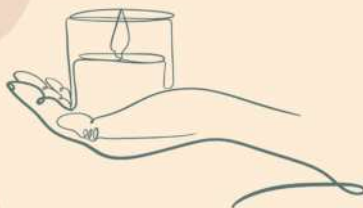

Flags in a Cemetery

According to the Federal Flag Code, American flags that are torn, faded, or otherwise damaged should be retired in a dignified manner—never thrown in the trash.

Local veterans' organizations and scout troops often hold ceremonies to respectfully dispose of worn flags. If you're unsure where to bring your flag, please contact the parish office, and we can help ensure it is properly cared for.

As Veterans Day approaches, many families place flags on the graves of loved ones who served. When the time comes to remove them, please remember to retire the flags respectfully.

Since several cemeteries are part of our parish family, please check with each one for their specific fall cleanup dates and winter regulations.

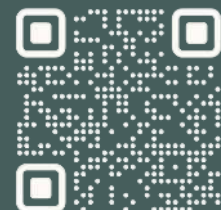

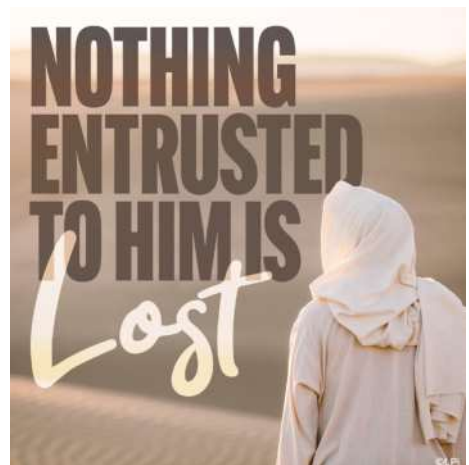

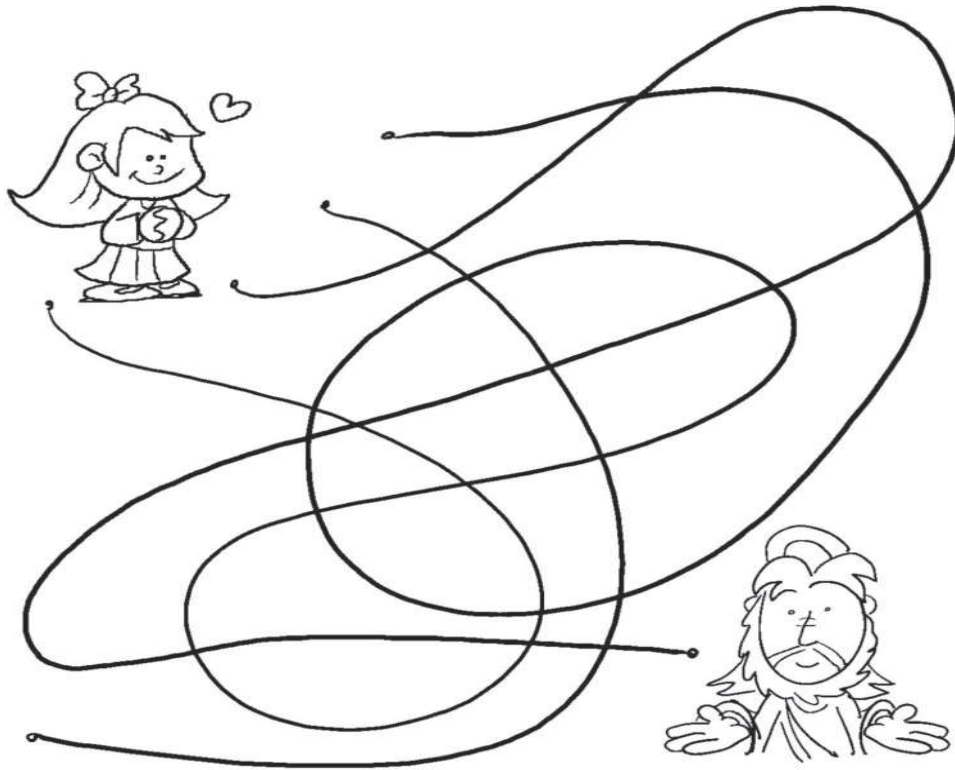
