'The Diocese has received recourse to the merger of St. Martha with St. Mary of the Assumption. Therefore, the merge is on hold until there is resolution. In the meantime, the parish will remain 'as is', meaning that sacraments will continue to be provided at St. Martha. It is important for parishioners to know that they must continue to support St. Martha during recourse so the parish remains viable. It is important to note that the 'as is' status means that St. Martha will continue to work within the family of parishes structure for the future success of your family.'
