

SIGNIFICANCE OF BAPTISM

On a Feast such as this we start to ask, why is Baptism so important for us as Catholics?

Baptism is the first and foundational sacrament of our faith. Through it:

We're claimed as children of God.
We're joined to Christ and share in His life.
We become part of the Church, the Body of Christ.
Our sins are washed away, and we receive the Holy Spirit to guide and strengthen us.

Baptism is the beginning of our whole Christian life. On that day, God speaks over each of us the same words He spoke over Jesus: "You are my beloved. You are mine."

This is also why holy water is so meaningful. When we bless ourselves as we enter or leave church, we're reminding ourselves of who we are and Whose we are. Each time we dip our fingers in holy water and make the Sign of the Cross, we're reconnecting with our baptismal calling and asking God to guide us as we go forward.

As we move into Ordinary Time, we carry with us the light of Christ that we celebrated throughout the Christmas season.
