HOLY WEEK 2026

March 29 - April 5

Walking with Christ

Holy Week is the **most sacred week of the Church year**.

During these days we follow Christ through the final moments of His earthly life.

It invites us not only to remember these events, but to walk with Christ from sacrifice to new life.

MONDAY, TUESDAY & WEDNESDAY OF HOLY WEEK

These days invite us to slow down and reflect on the final events leading to the Passion.

Monday – The Gospel reminds us of love and devotion, as Mary anoints Jesus in preparation for what is to come.

Tuesday – The Church gathers for the Diocesan Chrism Mass, where the Bishop blesses the sacred oils used for Baptism, Confirmation, Anointing of the Sick, and Holy Orders. Priests also renew their promises of service to God and His people.

Wednesday – Often called Spy Wednesday, we remember Judas' decision to betray Jesus – a reminder to examine our own hearts before entering the Triduum.

THE TRIDUUM

The Triduum is one continuous liturgy celebrated over next three days.

Holy Thursday

We remember the Last Supper, when Jesus gave us the gift of the Eucharist and the command to love and serve one another. The washing of the feet reminds us that Christian leadership is rooted in humble service. After Mass, the Eucharist is carried to the Altar of Repose, where we spend time in quiet prayer and adoration, keeping watch with Christ as He prayed in the Garden of Gethsemane before His Passion.


