In ***Eucharistic Adoration***, we spend quiet time in prayer before Jesus truly present in the Blessed Sacrament. **It is a chance to step away from the noise of daily life and simply be with Jesus.**

A ***Holy Hour*** is any dedicated time spent with Jesus in Adoration—whether for a full hour or even a shorter visit. Even a few peaceful minutes can be a grace-filled gift.

What Can I Do During a Holy Hour?

You do not need to “do it perfectly.”
Simply come and be with Him.

You might:

- Sit quietly and rest in His presence
- Speak to Jesus from your heart
- Thank Him for blessings received
- Ask for help or guidance
- Pray the Rosary or Divine Mercy Chaplet
- Read Scripture
- Offer prayers for loved ones or those in need
- Simply listen in silence
