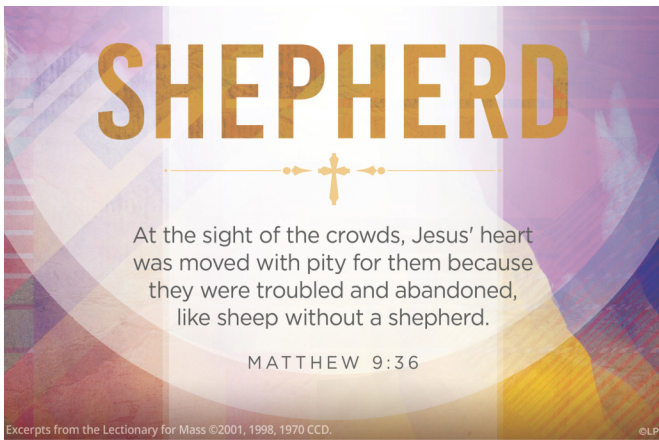

I will truly miss you. And **you will always have a special place not only in my prayers, but in my heart as well.**

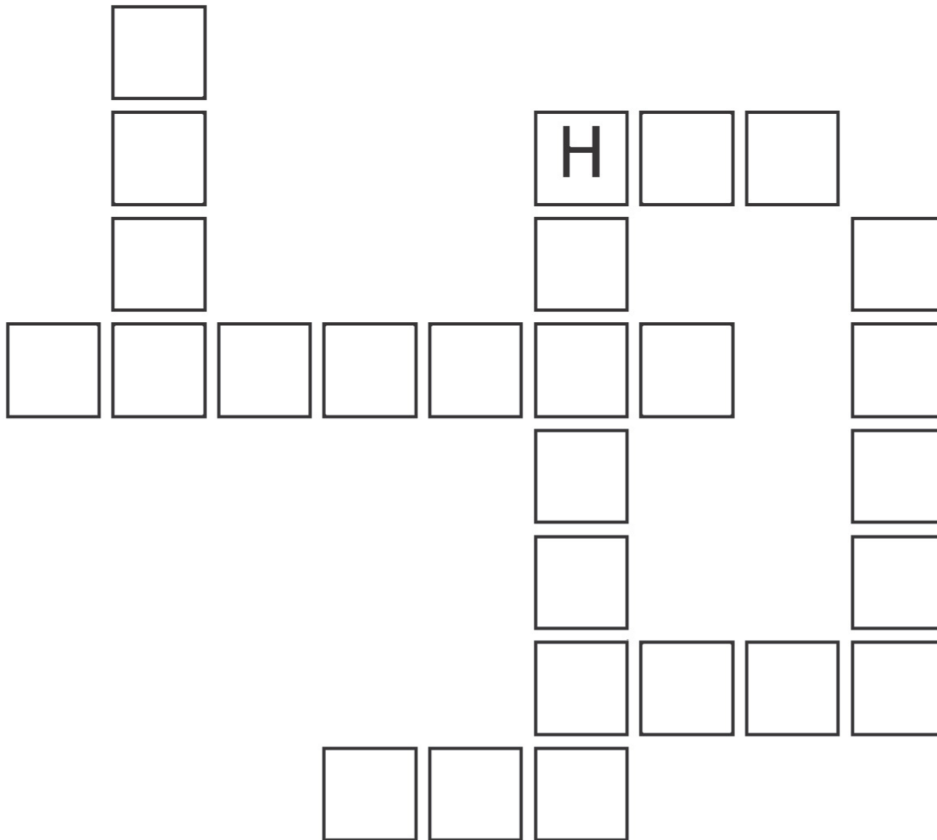
