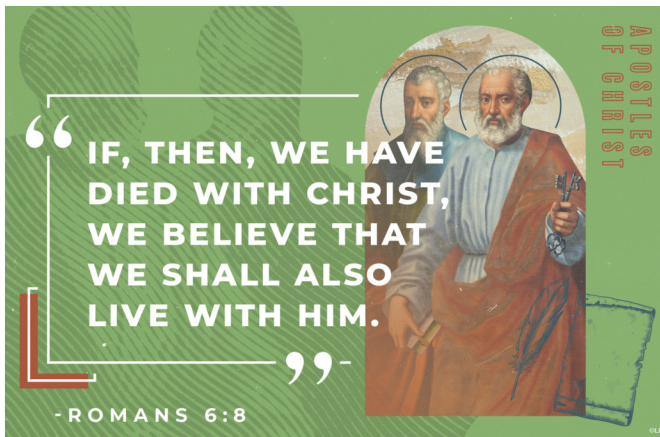

As Catholics, we look to St. Joseph, whose quiet faithfulness reminds us that love is often shown not through grand gestures, but through daily acts of care, protection, and service.

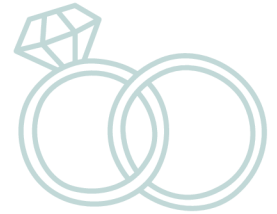
Today, we thank God for the men whose love, guidance, and example continue to shape our lives.
